

## Hendricks County Skywarn Net Script

At the request of the National Weather Service and Hendricks County Emergency Management, the Hendricks County Skywarn net has been activated. Your Net Control station is \_\_\_\_\_ (callsign) and my name is \_\_\_\_\_ (first name).

This net is being conducted on the 147.165 repeater in Danville. Please remember to key your radio, wait a second, and then talk to make sure the repeater hears you. Should this repeater fail, we will use the 147.015 repeater in Belleville as a backup.

This is a directed net and all traffic is to be routed through Net Control. When you check in, please give your callsign phonetically, your name, your location relative to towns or major crossroads, and whether you are base or mobile.

Is there any emergency or priority traffic for the net at this time?

Do we have anyone on frequency who would like to be our liaison to the Central Indiana Skywarn Net?

[Notes for Net Control: The Central Indiana Skywarn Net is on the 146.970 repeater with a 77 Hz tone or 442.650 repeater with a 77 Hz tone. If someone volunteers to be Liaison, please ask them to go the Central Indiana Skywarn net and ask if they have any traffic for our net.]

Any station wishing to check in to the Hendricks County Skywarn Net, please call \_\_\_\_\_ (call sign) now.

[Every 10 minutes, read the text of whatever Watch or Warning is currently active for Hendricks County and then make the following announcement about reporting criteria. Unkey periodically while you are reading this information in case someone has traffic for the net.]

The National Weather Service is looking for reports of weather events which you have personally observed that meet the following criteria:

- Tornados, funnel clouds, or rotating wall clouds
- Hail including the size of the hail
- Winds in excess of 50 miles per hour
- Flooding of creeks, streams, rivers, roads, or streets
- Heavy rain at a sustained rate greater than 1 inch per hour
- Damage to trees, power lines, or structures caused by wind

When you make your report, please give your exact location and the time the event occurred if your report is delayed.

Please do not call Net Control with reports of warning sirens being sounded. We are not responsible for the activation or operation of warning sirens.
